Reviewed SRTA & SRCS proposed guidelines in order to offer feedback and ask questions.

Distance Learning

Talked with Diann Kitamura and Rick Edson to speak with Rep Council about the expectations around Distance Learning.

- Being mentally healthy seems to be a priority for the district.
- DO would like our teachers to do the best we can and call that good.
- This would be a great time to try new things and learn new things without worrying about repercussions if things don't work out.
- We have an attendance component for the guidelines because it is a directive from the state. When taking attendance you are doing so for the prior week. DO is pushing for attendance to be taken no more than twice a week. Our connection with our students is the most important part. Taking attendance is checking a box for the state. Our attendance numbers will be what they are and the DO will be okay with the data whatever it was.
- It is still unknown if Summer School will take this year. The DO would like to avoid Distance Learning Summer School if possible. Students who are not passing the 3rd quarter and choose not to do work in the 4th quarter will not receive credit for the spring semester.
- Getting chromebook out to students was rushed because the DO wanted to get technology to students as soon as possible. They are now working on moving forward, taking the time to investigate, and get chromebooks into the hands of our most needy students. The DO is seeing an increase in the number of chromebooks that are being requested since the district said we won't be coming back to school in-person for the rest of the year.
- The DO is working on getting parents basic information on how to log on to google classroom (in English & Spanish). After we get chromebooks out to parents, they will

focus more on educating parents and students on how to use technology for education. The district is also creating a Distance Learning section on the SRCS website to help parents.

- Credit / No Credit is a possibility at the secondary level. The DO needs to talk more to SRTA and the principals before moving forward.
- Monday meetings and Check-In meetings with the principal are optional, but if the admin sends you an email or calls you to check-in, you are required to respond because you must be available at least one hour a day Tuesday - Friday.
